# Welcome

Here's wishing you all a very happy and dare I say healthy new year. That said sadly Covid is still with us and headlines the news on most days in the shape of Omicron, the latest variant, which seems to be spreading like wildfire in most parts of the UK. This means our lives are heading for a period of more restrictions which may impact all our ability to hold our Parish Council meetings. We will keep you posted on any developments as our first meeting of the year is scheduled for Weds 19th January.

## **Merger of Hempton and Pudding Norton Parish Councils**

The meeting of NNDC Councillors scheduled for 15<sup>th</sup> December was cancelled due to Covid. To the best of our knowledge the meeting in January is still expected to proceed and we then hope to receive a final decision.

## **Proposed Roundabout**

We received an email on the run up to Christmas notifying us the planning application period was opening on 15<sup>th</sup> December. No prior notification was given and the timing couldn't have been worse. Anyway, we managed to negotiate an extension of time from 8<sup>th</sup> January until 21<sup>st</sup> January...we also managed to get details out to all households in Hempton to enable you to get your comments back in time. We have received some feedback regarding difficulty with the weblink provided...please persevere and report any difficulties to the Clerk at [hemptonparishclerk@gmail.com](mailto:hemptonparishclerk@gmail.com) ...we will then let the planners know. The Parish Council are opposing the current proposal...however, we would like to stress it is not the principle of a roundabout, just its size and location. The current proposal is that the roundabout is not built at the existing junction but closer to peoples homes, resulting in the loss of approximately a third of The Green and green space close to Abbey Farm cottages and other homes on Dereham Road. Ideally other less invasive and disruptive mitigations are our preference. It is very important that your views are made to NCC. A reminder of how to make comments are below:-

## **Hempton Vicarage by Claire Travis**

As described in the November issue, The Old Vicarage was once a 'small parsonage' according to the recollections of Charles St Denys Moxon the first vicar, who had it built. The original building had servants' quarters, a coach house with stables and other outbuildings. Once the school moved into the Parish Rooms next to the church around 1874, the old school-room and rooms above were incorporated into the parsonage, along with the servants' quarters.

In 1975 the Vicarage was divided and the former servants' quarters were rented out as two flats. In 2003 the flats were incorporated back into the main house. Today it is just one private house.



The image dates from the 1920s or 30s and shows the extended parsonage. The entrance to the former school-room is the doorway in the very pale elevation. Today if you stroll past with your dog, you will notice that it is bricked up.

The building in its Old English architecture style had chimneys that are somewhat taller than necessary, crested ridge tiles (removed 1950s), high roof lines, gable ends, finials, fancy bargeboards and a steeply roofed porch. It also has two crosses in the brickwork formed using pale yellow bricks. All these features are known as Victorian Gothic or Gothic Revival. This style of building sought to go back to medieval styles, but nowadays we tend to think of it as just Victorian.

Can't wait to see what extra snippets of history will be revealed for the Vicarage and its residents with the release of the 1921 census (released 6 Jan 2022).

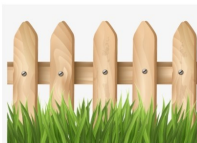
